TOURNAMENT PARKING IS AVAILABLE AT THESE LOCATIONS

Monday, April 30 – Friday, May 4

- Uptown Shuttle
- Carowinds – Parking & Shuttle
- CATS LYNX Blue Line Parking (see restrictions – ridetransit.org)

Saturday, May 5 and Sunday, May 6

- Uptown Shuttle
- Ballantyne Corporate Park – Parking & Shuttle
- SouthPark Area – Parking & Shuttle
- CATS LYNX Blue Line Parking (see restrictions – ridetransit.org)

Taxes, parking and shuttle fees, at authorized tournament lots, are included in the purchase of each ticket.

There is no public parking at Quail Hollow Club.

LEAVE THE CAR, RIDE THE RAIL

Ticketed patrons for the Wells Fargo Championship can conveniently utilize the CATS LYNX Blue Line to catch tournament shuttles.

- Tournament shuttles will ONLY be available from the Sharon Road West Light Rail Station.
- There will be no tournament parking at the Sharon Road West Station.
- To access tournament shuttles, all patrons MUST present a tournament ticket and a valid LYNX ticket purchased on the day of service from one of the LYNX stations OTHER THAN SHARON ROAD WEST. There will be NO exceptions.
- Patrons should exit trains at the station and follow signs to the shuttle loading area. Shuttle drop-off and pick-up will be at the main tournament entrance.
- Shuttles will be available from 5:30 a.m. - 9:00 p.m. daily.

UPTOWN SHUTTLE

Open Monday - Sunday, 5:30 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.

A complimentary Uptown Charlotte shuttle service will run Monday - Sunday 5:30 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., from the Charlotte Convention Center, Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. entrance. Event parking will be available in surrounding lots.

Please note: Uptown parking lots are not tournament-authorized. The tournament does not control the pricing or availability of Uptown parking.

CAROWINDS - PARKING & SHUTTLE

(TOURNAMENT-AUTHORIZED LOT)

Open Monday - Friday only, 5:30 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.

From I-77: Take I-77 to Exit 90 (the NC/SC border). Follow the signs to Carowinds.

From I-485: Take I-485 to I-77 South via Exit 67 toward Columbia. Take Carowinds Blvd. Exit 90. Follow the signs to Carowinds.

BALLANTYNE CORPORATE PARK - PARKING & SHUTTLE

(TOURNAMENT-AUTHORIZED LOT)

Open Saturday & Sunday only, 5:30 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.

From I-77: Take I-77 to I-485 Eastbound. Exit off of I-485 onto Johnston Road (Exit 61) going South. Ballantyne Corporate Park is on your right at the first stop light. Please follow the signs to designated parking areas.

SOUTHPARK AREA - PARKING & SHUTTLE

(TOURNAMENT-AUTHORIZED LOT)

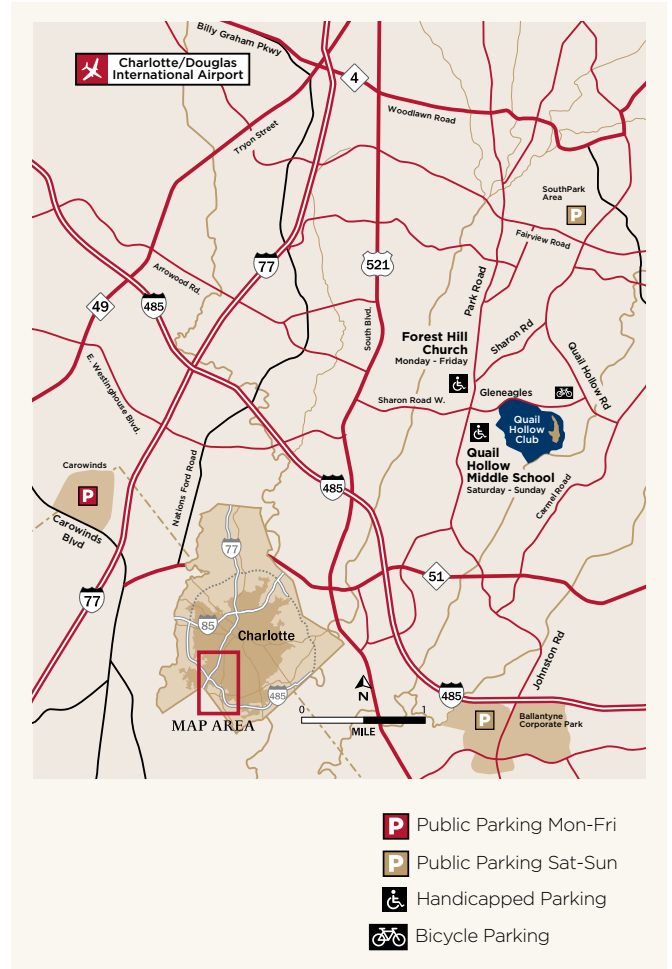
Open Saturday & Sunday only, 5:30 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.

From I-77N: Take Tyvola Road (Exit 5). Turn right onto Tyvola Road. (Tyvola becomes Fairview Road.) Turn left onto Barclay Downs and follow the signs to reserved designated parking areas.

From I-77S: Take Tyvola Road (Exit 5). Turn left onto Tyvola Road. (Tyvola becomes Fairview Road.) Turn left onto Barclay Downs and follow the signs to reserved designated parking areas.

From I-85N: Take Billy Graham Parkway (Exit 33). Turn right at top of ramp, go 2 miles and take the Tyvola Road exit (Tyvola becomes Fairview Road). Turn left onto Barclay Downs and follow the signs to reserved designated parking areas.

From I-85S: Take Exit 38 to I-77S. Follow I-77S directions.



HANDICAPPED PARKING

Patrons must apply for access to our Handicapped Parking lot. Please visit WellsFargoChampionship.com/handicappedparking to fill out an application.

Handicapped parking is located at Forest Hill Church, 7224 Park Road, on Mon.-Fri. ONLY and Quail Hollow Middle School, 2901 Smithfield Church Road, on Sat. & Sun. ONLY. Dedicated wheelchair-accessible buses will shuttle disabled persons and their guests to the tournament.

BICYCLE PARKING

The Wells Fargo Championship is a bicycle friendly tournament. Be more environmentally friendly and avoid riding the shuttles-ride your bicycle to the event! Bike racks will be provided in the gravel parking lot across from the main entrance of the club. There is a separate pedestrian entrance for patrons who ride their bikes or walk to the tournament. Please note the tournament is not liable for any stolen or damaged items.





MOBILE DEVICE / CELL PHONE POLICY

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used.
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use.
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage).
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas.
- Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media.
- All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed.
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in the revocation of your ticket.

LOST & FOUND ITEMS

Lost & Found will be located at the main Guest Services tent near the main shuttle drop-off/pick-up. Lost & Found items may be picked up prior to 6:00 p.m. on the day they are lost. WEATHER

Pertinent weather information will be provided in the Daily Pairings Guide. In the event of thunderstorms, lightning or other severe weather, "Weather Warning" information will be displayed on the electronic scoreboards around the golf course. When these warnings appear, spectators are advised to take precautions and seek shelter even before play is suspended. If the siren sounds suspending play, seek shelter immediately. The electronic scoreboards will keep spectators advised as to the length of delay of play.

TICKETS

Please remember that all sales are final, no refunds. Tickets cannot be exchanged or replaced if lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed. Tickets cannot be resold. Children 12 and under are admitted free with grounds access when accompanied by an adult ticket holder (one child per adult). This excludes the Executive Club. All guests two years and older require an Executive Club ticket.

WILL CALL

Proper photo ID is required. Will Call will be located at the following locations:

Symphony Park – Off-Site Will Call Location

Located in the parking lot of Symphony Park (the Reid's Fine Foods parking lot at the intersection of Carnegie Blvd. and Barclay Downs Drive).

Open Monday, April 30 – Saturday, May 5 from 6:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m., and Sunday, May 6 from 6:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Quail Hollow Club – On-Site Will Call Location

Located conveniently in the main bus drop off at Quail Hollow Club. Upon arrival, please look for the "Will Call" tent.

Open Monday, April 30 – Saturday, May 5 from 6:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m., and Sunday, May 6 from 6:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- No Backpacks, Seat Cushions, or Coolers of any kind
- No Opaque Bags larger than 6"x6"x6" (in their natural state)
- No Clear Tote Bags, Plastic, Vinyl, or other carry items larger than 12"x 6"x 12"
- No Chair Bags (Folding chairs are permitted - the sleeves that hold them are not)
- No Lawn or Oversized Chairs
- No Pets except for service animals
- No Video Cameras at any time
- No Cameras or Go-Pros after Wednesday(Camera lens must fit within 6"x6" restrictions)
- No Selfie Sticks
- No Computers or Laptops
- No Whistles, Horns or Noise Makers
- No Radios, Televisions, or other electronic noise-producing items
- No Signs, Banners, Poles or Rods
- No Alcoholic Beverages may enter or leave the Tournament
- No outside Food or Beverages may enter the Tournament except for medical or infant needs
- No Plastic, Metal, or Glass Cups, Cans or Containers except for medical or infant needs
- No Weapons of any kind may enter the tournament including, but not limited to, firearms or knives
- No Fireworks or Laser Pointers
- No Illegal Substances
- No other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the PGA TOUR Tournament Security Officials

All items are subject to search. You will be asked to return all unauthorized items to your car before you are allowed to board shuttles. Tournament is not responsible for personal items left unattended.

AUTOGRAPH POLICY

During official competitive rounds (Thursday – Sunday), a player cannot sign autographs after the start of his round until it is complete. An autograph area will be designated at the tournament. Players have the option to use this area.

SUGGESTED ATTIRE

Appropriate casual golf wear with comfortable walking shoes (soft spikes only). Spectators should have these items on hand: windbreaker, hat/visor, sunscreen, sunglasses and umbrella.
