



Participating Charities

1. Participating charities must be publicly supported and recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)(3) organization.
2. Interested charities must apply to participate in the program. The Wells Fargo Championship Board of Directors has the authority to approve/deny any charity application in its sole discretion.
3. The 2021 Birdies for Charlotte Charities fundraising program will officially launch on January 11, 2021 and extend through Wednesday, May 5, 2021. Only pledges and Birdies guesses submitted via official pledge form or online portal will be accepted.
4. Pledges and guesses for the Guess the Birdies grand prize must be submitted by start of tournament play on Thursday, May 6, 2021.
5. The maximum match a charity can receive is \$5,000. If a charity raises more than \$100,000, they will not receive more than \$5,000. "Self Pledges" (pledges made on behalf of an organization and paid by the organization) are not permitted and may not be used towards the Bonus Pool.
6. Participating charities may not solicit pledges in advance of the official pledge period as defined by the Wells Fargo Championship.
7. Donations should be a minimum of one cent (\$0.01) per birdie or a one-time flat donation of \$20.
8. Clear, legible handwriting is the responsibility of all participants. Pledges and payments without a clearly identifiable designated charity will go towards the Birdies for Charlotte Charities Bonus Pool fund. All Birdies for Charlotte Charities Bonus Pool funds will be used as a part of the bonus pool benefitting all qualified charities.
9. Should the PGA TOUR or Tournament Officials cancel one or more rounds of the tournament play because of weather or other conditions, the following numbers of birdies shall be added to the actual birdies total to determine the total number of birdies made for this contest.
 - a. Thursday & Friday – 400 Birdies added each cancelled day
 - b. Saturday & Sunday – 200 Birdies added each cancelled day
10. Rules and regulations may be amended or changed at the sole discretion of the Wells Fargo Championship.
11. Organizations must agree to promote the Wells Fargo Championship and Birdies for Charlotte Charities utilizing approved tournament-provided collateral and to also make a social post of appreciation after receiving support monies.
12. Limited use of the trademarks of The Wells Fargo Championship and Birdies for Charlotte Charities will be granted to all participating charities. Samples of materials bearing the trademarks must be submitted to the Wells Fargo Championship for approval prior to distribution.
13. Bonus pool monies are at the discretion of the Wells Fargo Championship Board of Directors and will only be distributed to participating charities if they fulfill the promotional requirements indicated in this program description.
14. The Wells Fargo Championship is not responsible for pledge forms received after Wednesday, May 5, 2021.



BFCC “Guess the Birdies” Contest

1. The Birdies for Charlotte Charities “Guess the Birdies” contest is open to all participants 18 years of age or older. The contest is void where prohibited by law. A participant need not be present to win.
2. No pledge, purchase or donation is required to participate in the Birdies for Charlotte Charities “Guess the Birdies” Contest to become eligible to receive a prize. A pledge will not increase a participant’s likelihood of winning a prize.
3. Only (1) Grand Prize will be awarded to the individual who guesses the exact number of birdies made during the 2021 Wells Fargo Championship. In the case of a tie (or ties), tournament officials will choose the winner by random drawing from among those whose guess was closest to the number of birdies, either above or below the exact number of birdies made.
4. The exact number of birdies made during the tournament will include all birdies made by PGA TOUR professionals beginning Thursday, May 6 – Sunday, May 9, 2021, plus any birdies made during a playoff round (if applicable).
5. Participants are limited to thirty (30) total submissions per person. Each pledge/guess must be submitted on a separate entry form. If more than thirty (30) guesses are submitted by an individual, only the first thirty (30) guesses received and recorded will be eligible for prizes.
6. Wells Fargo Championship staff, board members, and family members of the aforementioned organizations are not eligible for the Grand Prize.
7. All Birdies for Charlotte Charities “Guess the Birdies” prizes are subject to change without notice at any time and at the sole discretion of tournament officials.
8. Prizes cannot be exchanged for cash. Winner is responsible for any applicable taxes related to the prizes.
