Tournament parking is available at the locations listed below. Please be sure to check the days, times, and payment options carefully to ensure you utilize the proper lot for the day/s you plan to attend.

There is no public parking at Quail Hollow Club.

Ticketed patrons for the Wells Fargo Championship can conveniently utilize the CATS LYNX Blue Line to catch tournament shuttles.

- Tournament shuttles will ONLY be available from the Sharon Road West Light Rail Station.
- There will be NO tournament parking at the Sharon Road West Station.
- To access tournament shuttles, all patrons MUST present a valid LYNX ticket purchased on the day of service from one of the LYNX stations OTHER THAN SHARON ROAD WEST. There will be NO exceptions.
- Patrons should exit trains at the station and follow signs to the shuttle loading area. Shuttle drop-off and pick-up will be at the main tournament entrance.



RIDESHARE DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

Patrons can utilize the ridesahre apps to request rides for drop-off and pick-up during the tournament. HANDICAPPED PARKING

Handicapped parking is located at Forest Hill Church, 7224 Park Road, on Mon. - Fri. ONLY and Quail Hollow Middle School, 2901 Smithfield Church Road, on Sat. & Sun. ONLY. Dedicated wheelchair-accessible buses will shuttle disabled persons and their guests to the tournament.

MOBILE DEVICE / CELL PHONE POLICY

- Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used.
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week.

- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage).
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week.
- Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas.

LOST & FOUND ITEMS

Lost & Found will be located at the main Guest Services tent near the main shuttle drop-off/pick-up. Lost & Found items may be picked up prior to 6:00 p.m. on the day they are lost. WEATHER

Observe the leaderboards throughout the golf course for "Weather Warning" signs that will appear prior to inclement weather. Spectators are advised to take precautions PRIOR to play being suspended. Avoid the following: tented structures, open areas, hilltops and/or high places, bleachers, isolated trees, golf carts, and wire fences. Please do not presume that play will be canceled if there is a weather event. Re-entry to the tournament will be allowed following a suspension of play.

TICKETS

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- No backpacks, seat cushions, or coolers of any kind
- No opaque bags larger than 6"x6"x6" (in their natural state)
- No clear tote bags, plastic, vinyl, or other carry items larger than 12"x 6"x 12'
- No chair bags (folding chairs are permitted - the sleeves that hold them are not)
- No lawn or oversized chairs
- No pets except for service animals
- . No video cameras at any time
- No cameras or Go-Pros after Wednesday (camera lens must fit within 6"x6" restrictions)
- No selfie sticks
- No computers or laptops
- · No whistles, horns or noise makers

- · No radios, televisions, or other electronic noise-producing items
- No signs, banners, poles or rods
- No alcoholic beverages may enter or leave the Tournament
- · No outside food or beverages may enter the Tournament except for medical or infant needs
- No glass cups or bottles except for medical or infant needs
- No weapons of any kind may enter the tournament including, but not limited to, firearms or knives
- · No fireworks or laser pointers
- No illegal substances
- No other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the PGA TOUR Tournament Security Officials

All items are subject to search. There is no check tent so you will be asked to return all unauthorized items to your car before you are allowed to board shuttles. Tournament is not responsible for personal items left unattended.

AUTOGRAPH POLICY

Autographs will only be permitted in the Autograph Zone for the 2024 Wells Fargo Championship. The Autograph Zone will be located behind the Clubhouse near the Main Tournament Putting Green.

SUGGESTED ATTIRE

Appropriate casual golf wear with comfortable walking shoes (soft spikes only). Spectators should have these items on hand: windbreaker, hat/visor, sunscreen, sunglasses and umbrella.

CHILD POLICY

Children 15 and under are admitted free (grounds access only) when accompanied by an adult ticket holder (one child per adult).
